The GLCAP Marine Services Technician Apprenticeship Program provides students with skills and training they need for successful careers in the marine industry.

Students learn through a combination of classroom instruction and hands-on experience. Practical, fast-track career training is provided through Terra State Community College, Vanguard-Sentinel Career & Technology Centers, Associated Builders and Contractors, and other partners.

Coursework includes:

- Marine technician certification
- Marine electricity and electronics
- Forklift operator training
- HVAC troubleshooting
- Welding (American Welding Society credential)
- Basic computer and internet
- U.S. Coast Guard Auxiliary, Ohio Boating Safety Training
- ODNR Ohio Boating Law
- Occupational Health & Safety Administration (OSHA) certification
- CPR/first aid and Automated External Defibrillator
