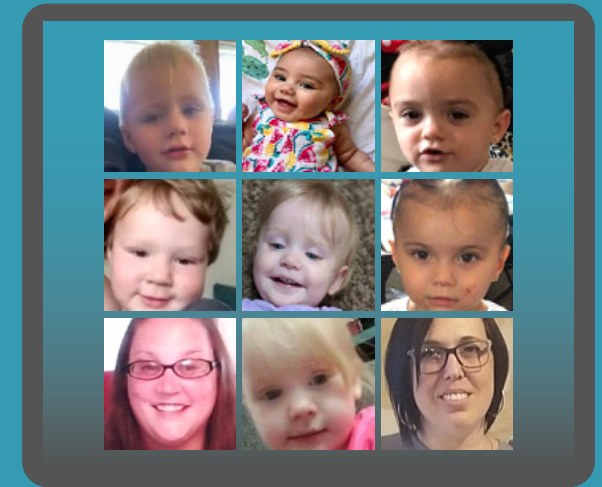

GLCAP provides parent and child education, support for families, and many opportunities to ensure that children are ready for school. Staff help parents create goals for their children and for their families; connect with community resources; and build upon their position as the most important educational resource in their children's lives.

Our program provides:

- Weekly scheduled visits at a convenient time for families
- Parent coaching and mentoring
- Assistance with development of family routines
- Parent-directed school readiness activities
- Two play groups per month
- Services for children with disabilities
- Volunteer opportunities
- Policy Council and Parent Committee participation
- Parent-teacher conferences
- Referrals to community resources, including transportation needs and resources
