## 2024 GLCAPANNUAL REPORT We create partnerships and opportunities to help individuals, families, and communities thrive



GLCAP's Early Head Start, Head Start, Migrant & Seasonal Head Start, and Home-Based programs provided preschool and childcare for 1,853 children, while Afterschool/Summer School program offered tutoring, STEM activities, and more for 173 elementary and high school students.

#### **COMMUNITY & RURAL DEVELOPMENT**

The Rural Community Assistance Program (RCAP) worked with 917 communities in its seven-state region, providing technical training to 2,685 local utility personnel and other participants. RCAP also helped communities leverage \$128,443,052 in funds for local projects. Additionally, staff provided GIS (geographic information system) services to map utility lines in 33 communities, and offered 99 rural residents well assessments or septic system replacements.

#### **FINANCIAL WELLNESS & WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT**

The **WorkAdvance program** connected 198 people to employment in advanced manufacturing industries. **Financial Opportunity Center** coaches assisted 129 people with financial literacy education, employment and training, and income supports.

#### HOME REPAIR & ENERGY EFFICIENCY -

The Home Weatherization Assistance Program (HWAP) program made 250 homes safer and more energy-efficient with added insulation and other energy-saving measures, while 571 households reduced energy usage through participation in the Electric Partnership Program. Also, GLCAP's Home Repair program provided 59 homes with plumbing, electrical, roof, and other needed repairs.

#### **HOUSING & UTILITY SUPPORT**

Utility assistance programs supported 2,591 households with summer utility or winter utility assistance, or water utility expenses, along with helping 2,322 utility customers set up affordable monthly payment plans based on income. Along with this support, 737 families were offered safe, stable housing to prevent homelessness, including 249 veteran households.

#### **SENIOR SERVICES & PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION**

Senior Services staff brought nutrition, education, and other programs to 883 seniors in Sandusky County, and also supported 438 seniors via Meals on Wheels. The Senior Helping Hands program also provided 31 health and safety-related home repairs for senior households. Transportation staff gave 38,994 rides on TRIPS Demand-Response and Fremont Shuttle services in Sandusky County.
