GLCAP housing assistance programs are available in a 15-county northwest Ohio region. We offer both short-term and long-term assistance options; requirements vary depending on program and county.

### **Benefits for Landlords**

We help landlords fill unoccupied units by linking them with tenants in need. GLCAP staff work with tenants by providing case management, budgeting and other supportive services to help ensure they remain stable and responsible occupants.

## **Our Programs**

## **Permanent Supportive Housing**

In the PSH program, GLCAP serves as the leaseholder and enters into an initial one-year lease for the property. During the lease term, GLCAP pays the full rent directly to the landlord. Program availability is limited.

# Homeless Crisis Response Program/HUD Rapid Rehousing; Supportive Services for Veteran Families (SSVF); Youth Homelessness Demonstration Program (YHDP)

Our housing programs provide rental assistance that varies for each participant and is based on their individual needs. In these programs, the tenant serves as the leaseholder and must meet specific program requirements to continue receiving assistance. When applicable, participants are responsible for paying rent directly to the landlord.

### **Helpful Information**

#### **Payments**

- · Direct deposits are available.
- Payments can take up to 30 days after you receive the intent to pay. After 30 days, contact your advocate.
  We are not able to look up payments prior to 30 days.
- Landlords with multiple tenants may receive more than one payment per month.

#### **Business Information**

- If your property is under a business/LLC, you will need to provide your business name and EIN number.
- If your property is personally owned, you will need to provide your name and social security number.
- All checks will be issued to the name on your W-9.
