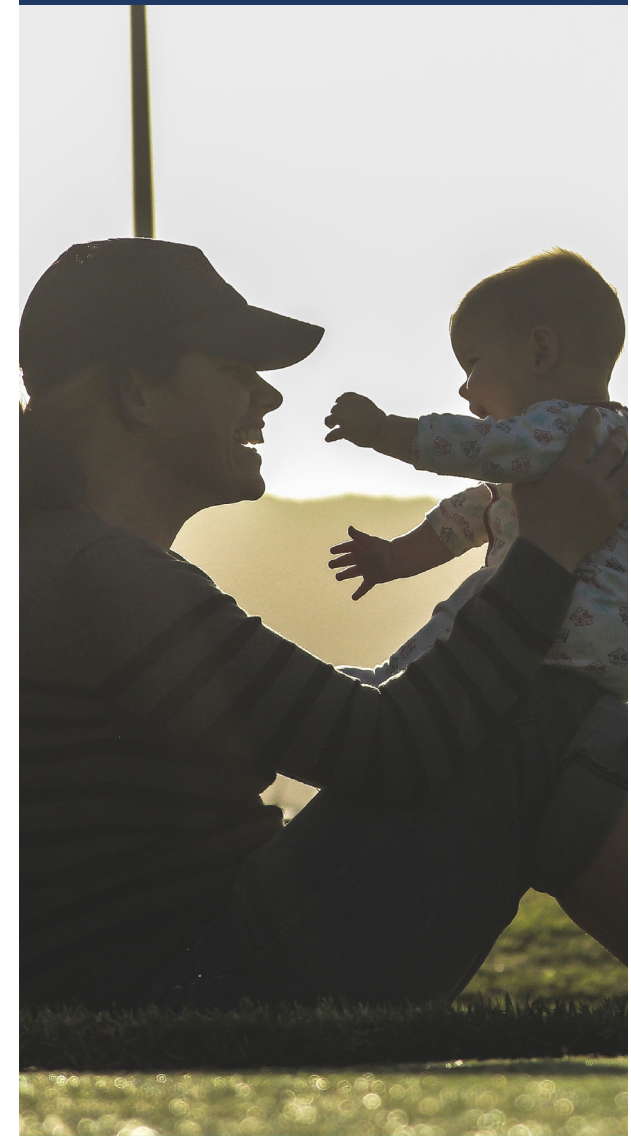

We can help you get back home

If you homeless or facing homelessness, Great Lakes Community Action Partnership can help.

We offer **Rapid Rehousing** assistance for short-term housing aid, as well as **Permanent Supportive Housing** assistance provides long-term housing aid for clients who are homeless, have at least one family member with a disability verified by a licensed professional, and are able to live independently and care for themselves. Long-term assistance is also available for victims of domestic violence. Clients in either program must be able to find a housing unit with a fair market rent and a landlord willing to work with the program, and pay 30% of their gross income towards rent.

U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) guidelines consider persons to be homeless if they are living in an emergency shelter, motel paid for by a charitable organization, tent or campground, or a place not meant to be lived in such as a car, park, or abandoned building.
