

WORKADVANCE PROGRAM

GLCAP launched the WorkAdvance program in 2023 in partnership with the Ohio Manufacturers' Association (OMA) to provide workforce training and solutions for advanced manufacturing careers in the northwest Ohio area.

OUTCOMES FOR GLCAP WORKADVANCE, 2023-2026

184 participants in GLCAP's WorkAdvance program across five counties — Crawford, Ottawa, Sandusky, Seneca, and Wyandot

71 Individuals who completed welding trainings and/or OSHA 10 trainings through WorkAdvance

50 Students who completed welding certification training, offered in five different cohorts of classes

40 Participants who completed upskilling training that led to a wage increase and/or promotion at work



122 Individuals who were connected to new careers through job placement or upskilled to receive a wage increase or promotion at their workplace

\$22.25 Average wage for workers attaining careers through job placement via WorkAdvance

\$32.34 Average wage for workers who received upskilling training that led to a promotion or increased pay
